FACT SHEET

History & Purposes

Incorporated in August 2001 as a 501(c)(3) charitable nonprofit exempt organization, the Health & Welfare Foundation of Southern Chester County (HWFSCC) was established to receive the net proceeds from the sale of Southern Chester County Medical Center (SCCMC) and subsequent merger of Jenner's Pond. It is the Foundation's responsibility to:

- Be the steward for trust funds and past gifts entrusted for the benefit of SCCMC;
- Manage, use and distribute those funds to promote and improve the health and welfare of people in the Foundation's defined service area and
- Receive, manage, use and distribute other property or funds for the general benefit of the people in its service area.

Current Status of the Foundation

Since 2005 the Board of Directors established funding priorities, initiated a request for proposal process, and has distributed over \$2 million to organizations meeting the health and welfare needs of Southern Chester County residents. The Foundation continues to administer several restricted funds established previously. The Alma Newlin Scholarship Fund has provided in the past twelve years over \$1 million in scholarships for outstanding qualified local students entering or furthering their education in a healthcare-related field.

Community Resource

Assets of the Foundation total approximately \$4.2 million. Special funds can be established which meet the donor's needs while at the same time achieving a charitable purpose. You are encouraged to consider using the Foundation as a resource to achieve the goals of your estate plan while you also help your community.

Service Area

The Foundation's primary service area for funding purposes extends to the geographic boundaries of the five school districts serving Southern Chester County (Avon Grove, Kennett, Octorara, Oxford, and Unionville-Chadds Ford).
